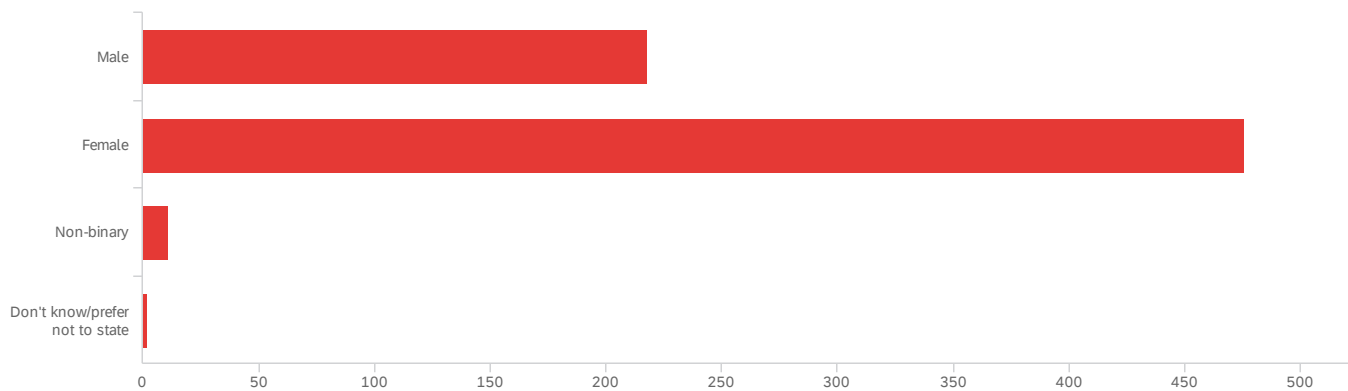

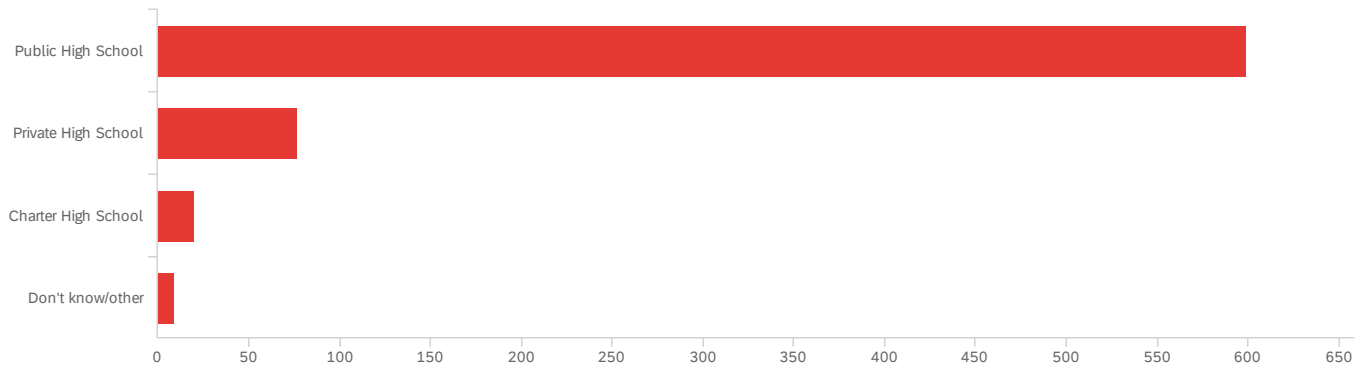

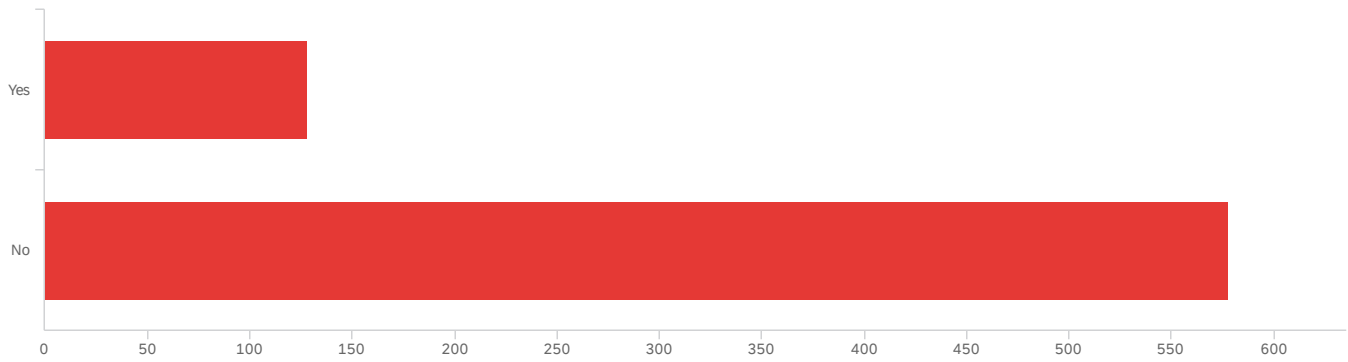

Q1.6 - Are you a community college transfer student?



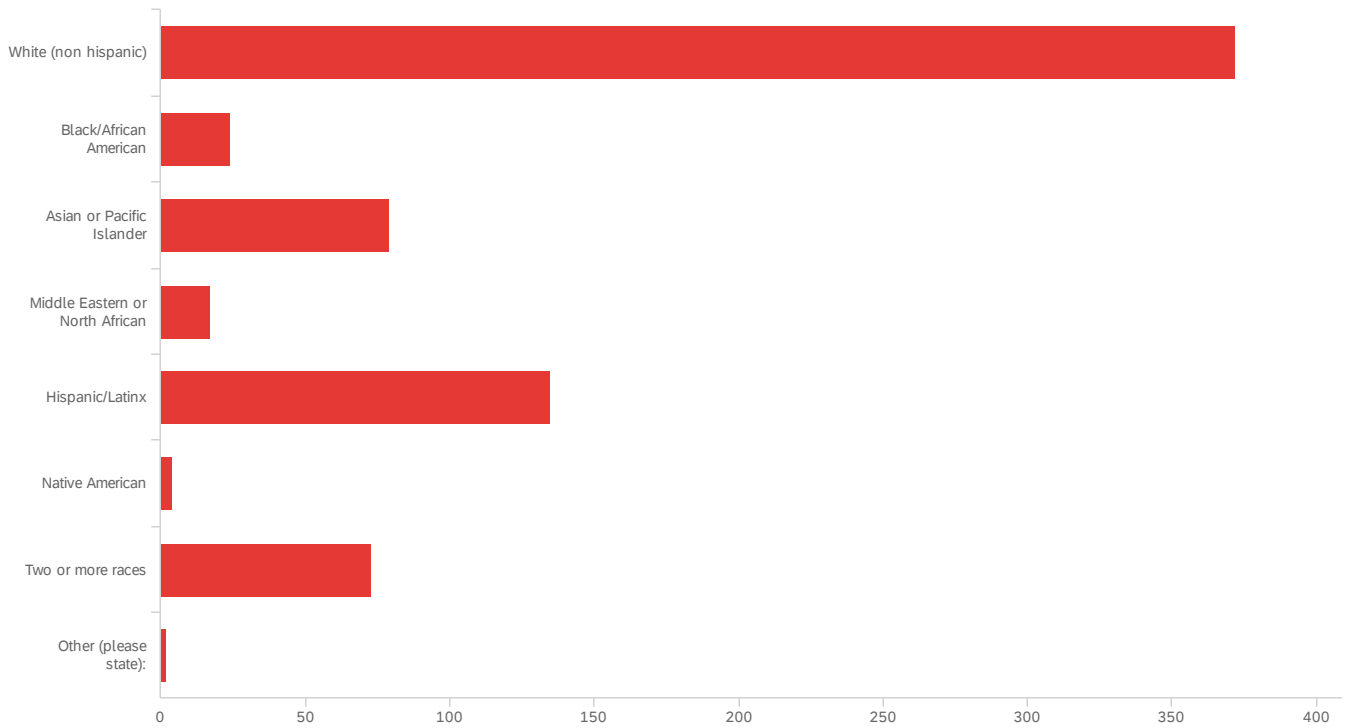

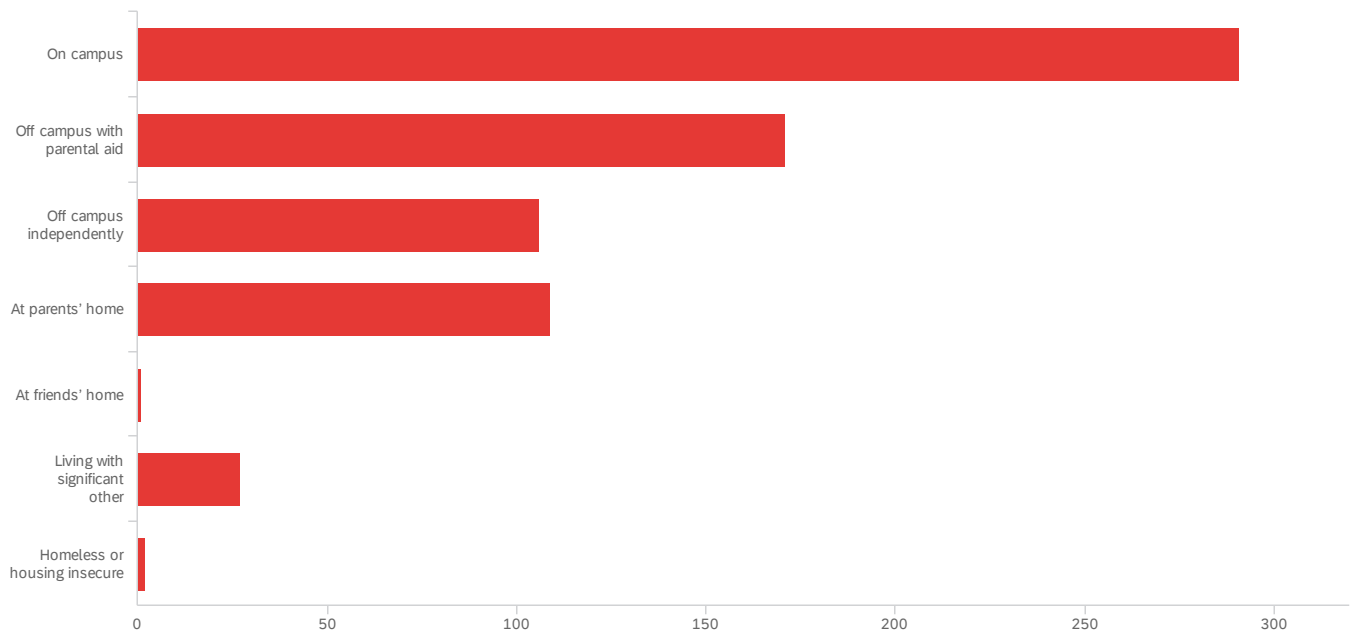

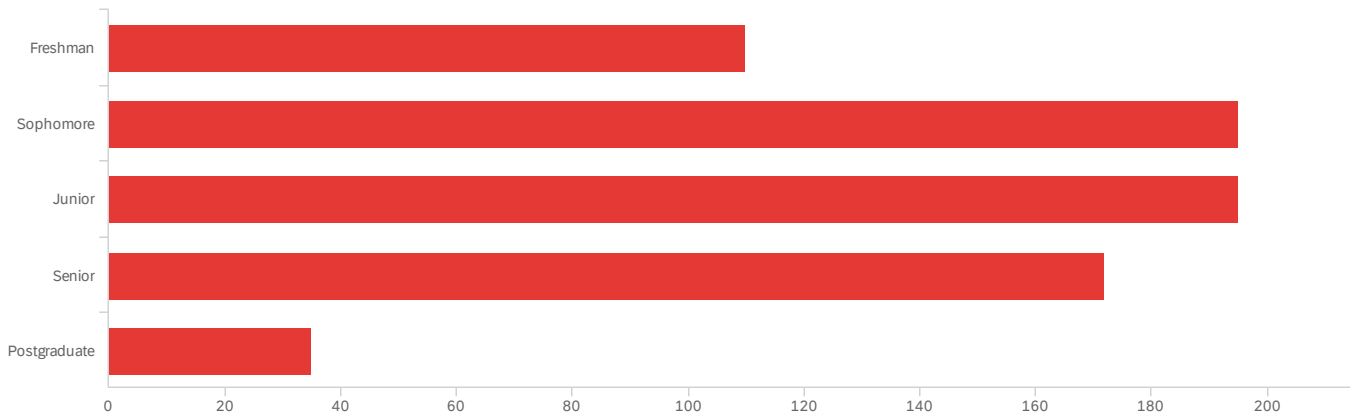

Q1.9 - What best describes your current academic year?

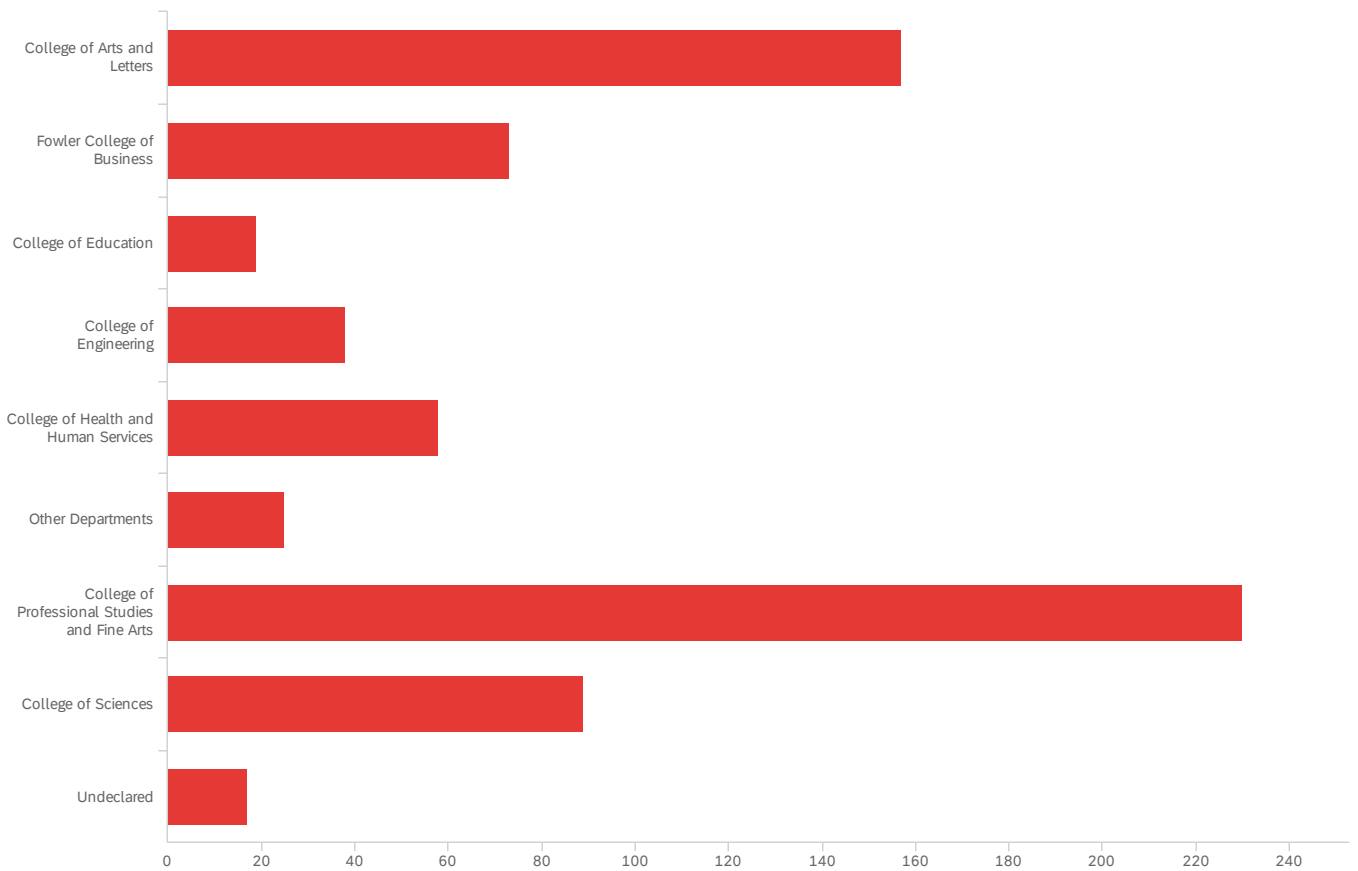

Q1.10 - Which college does your major fall under?



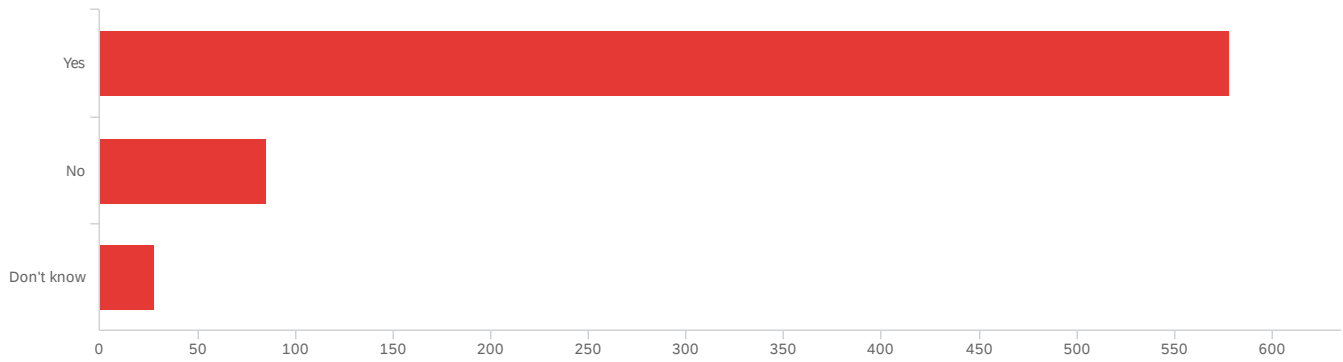

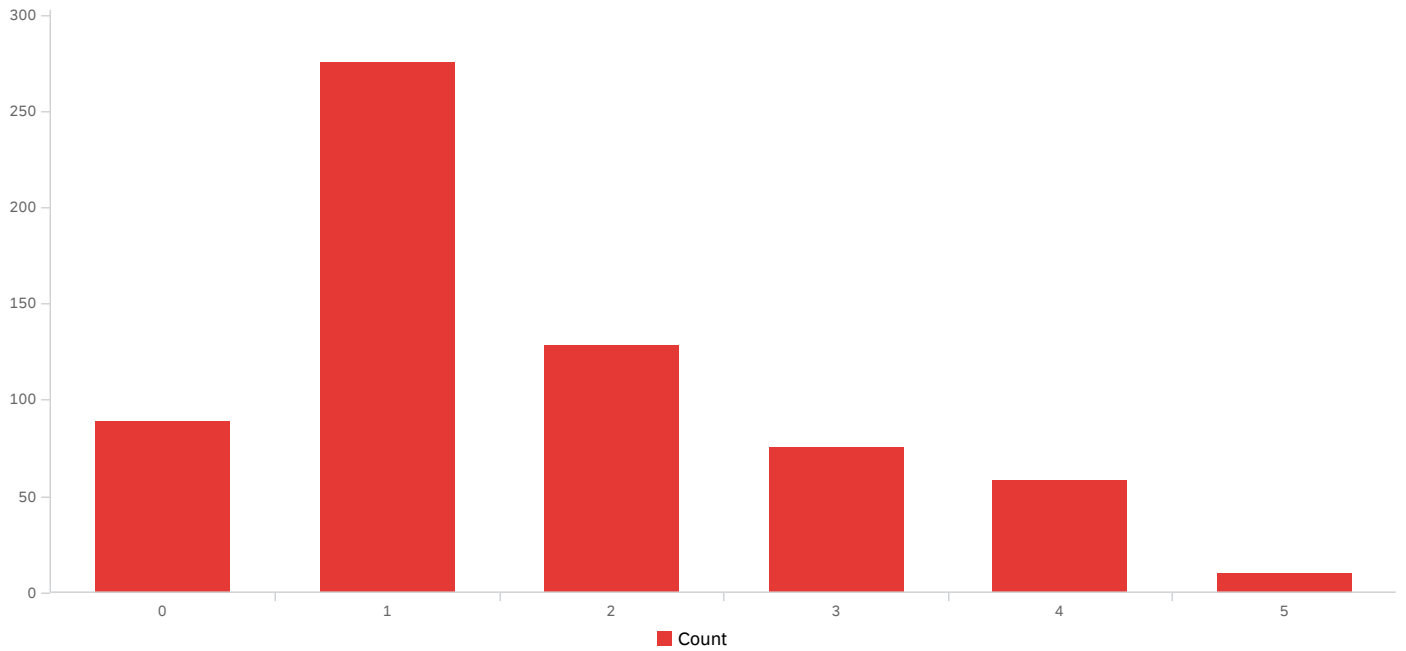

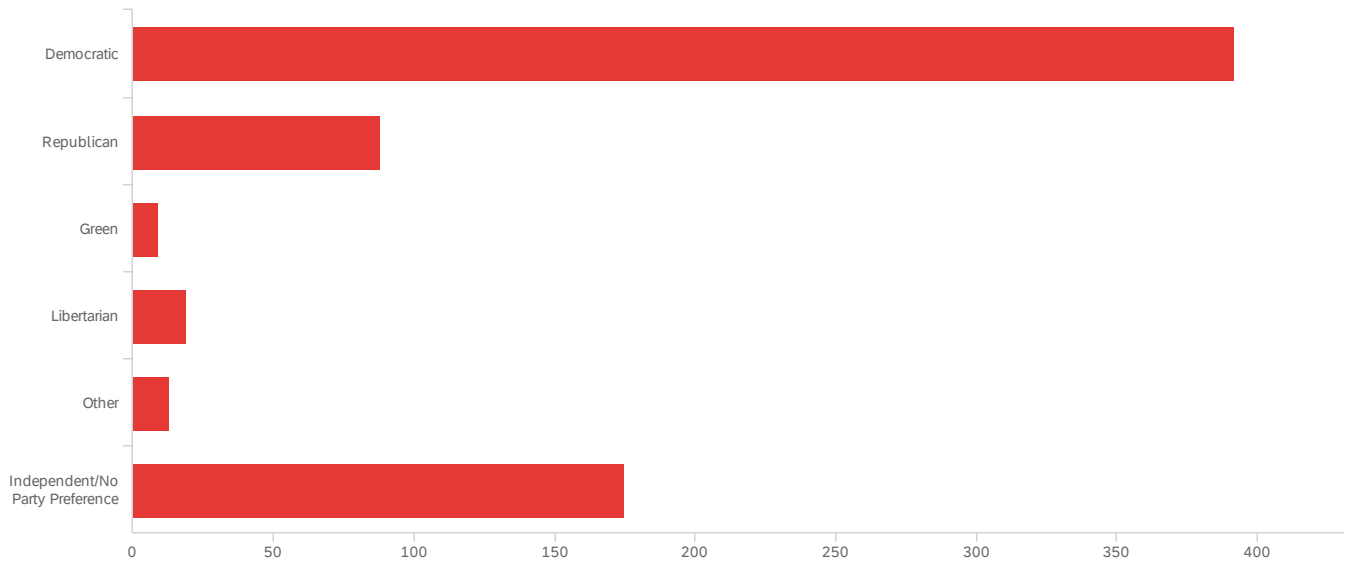

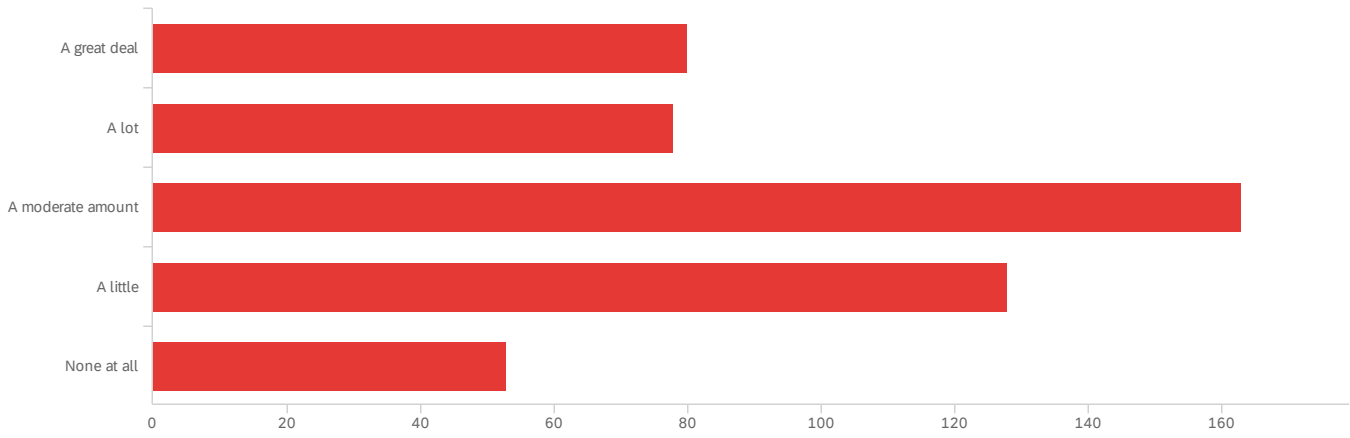

Q2.4 - Right now, how much attention are you paying to Democratic candidates running for the 2020 Presidential nomination?

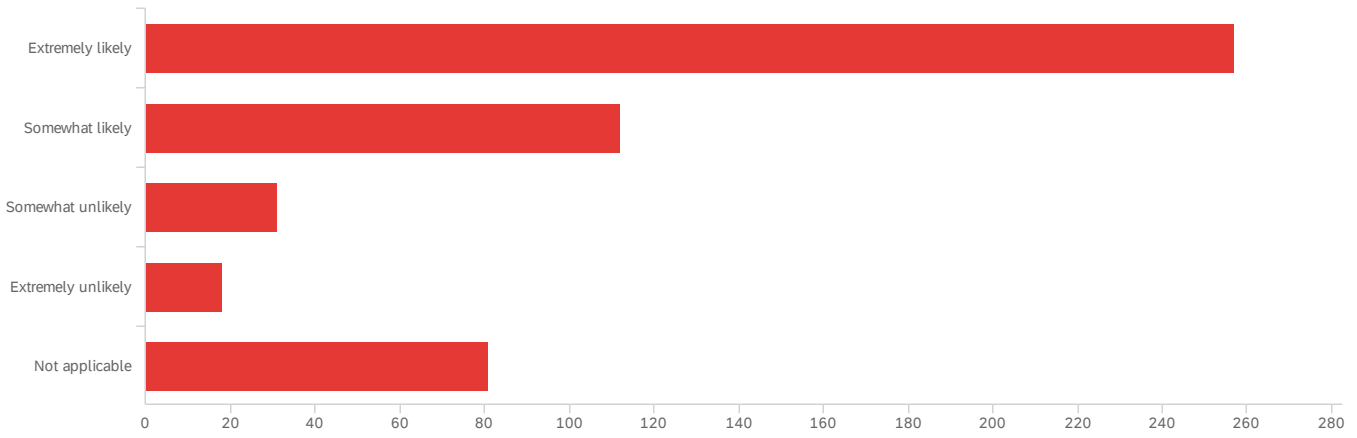

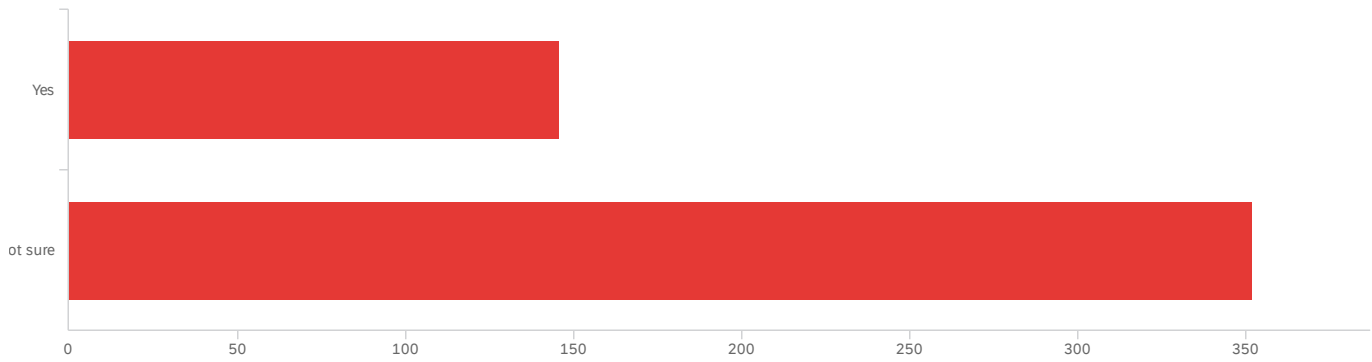

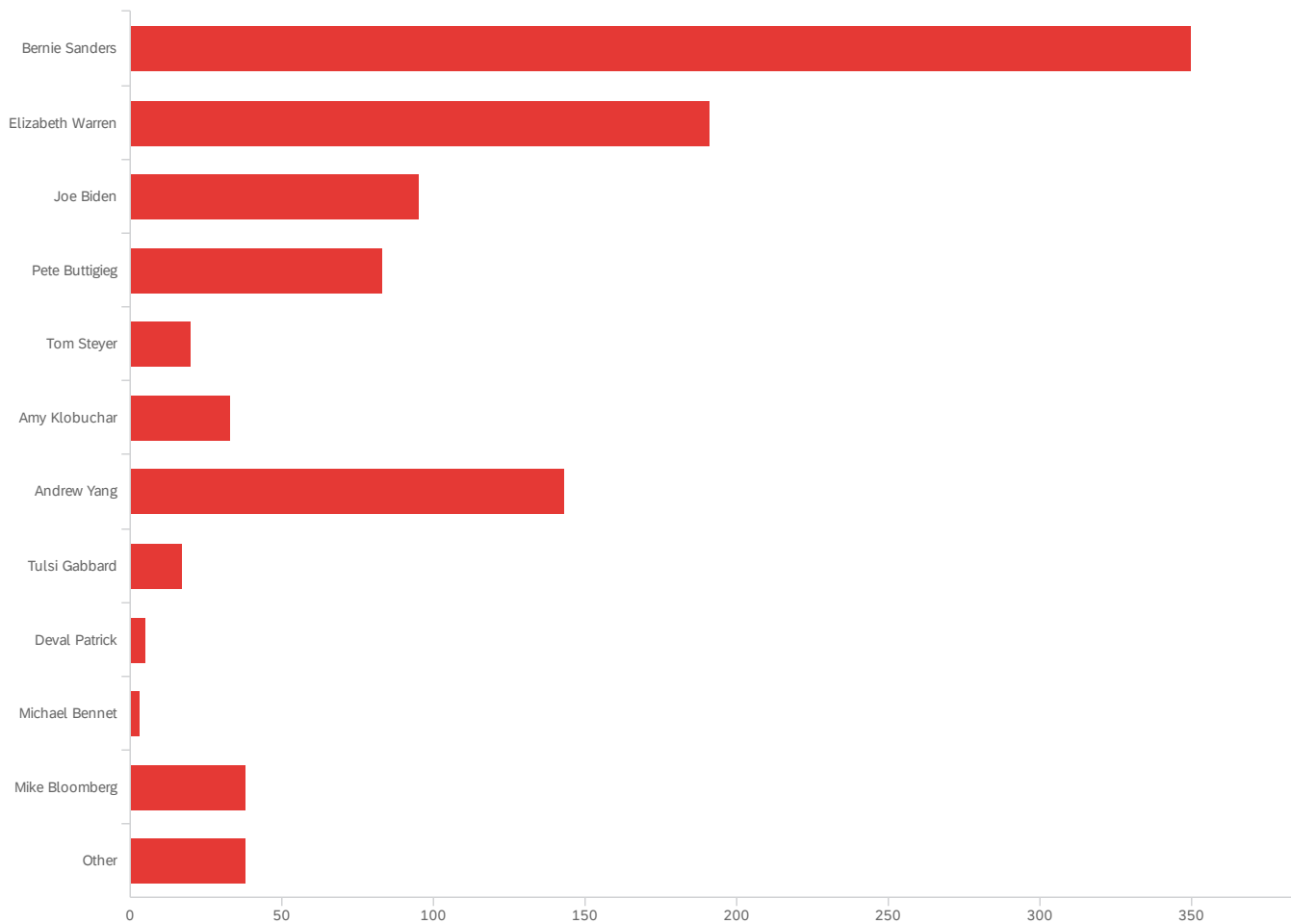

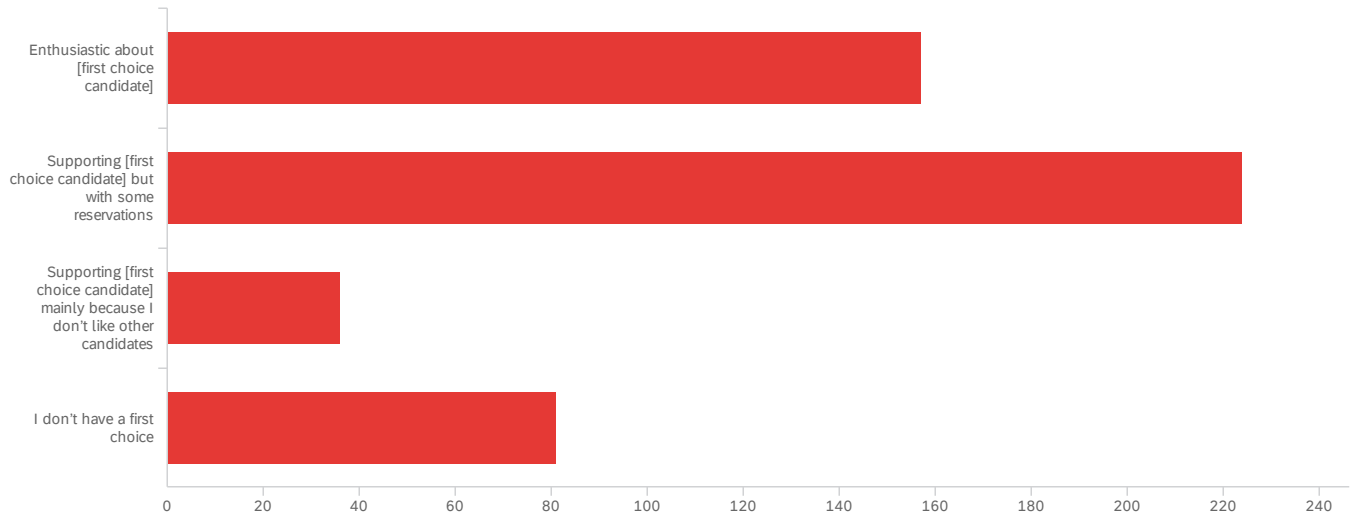

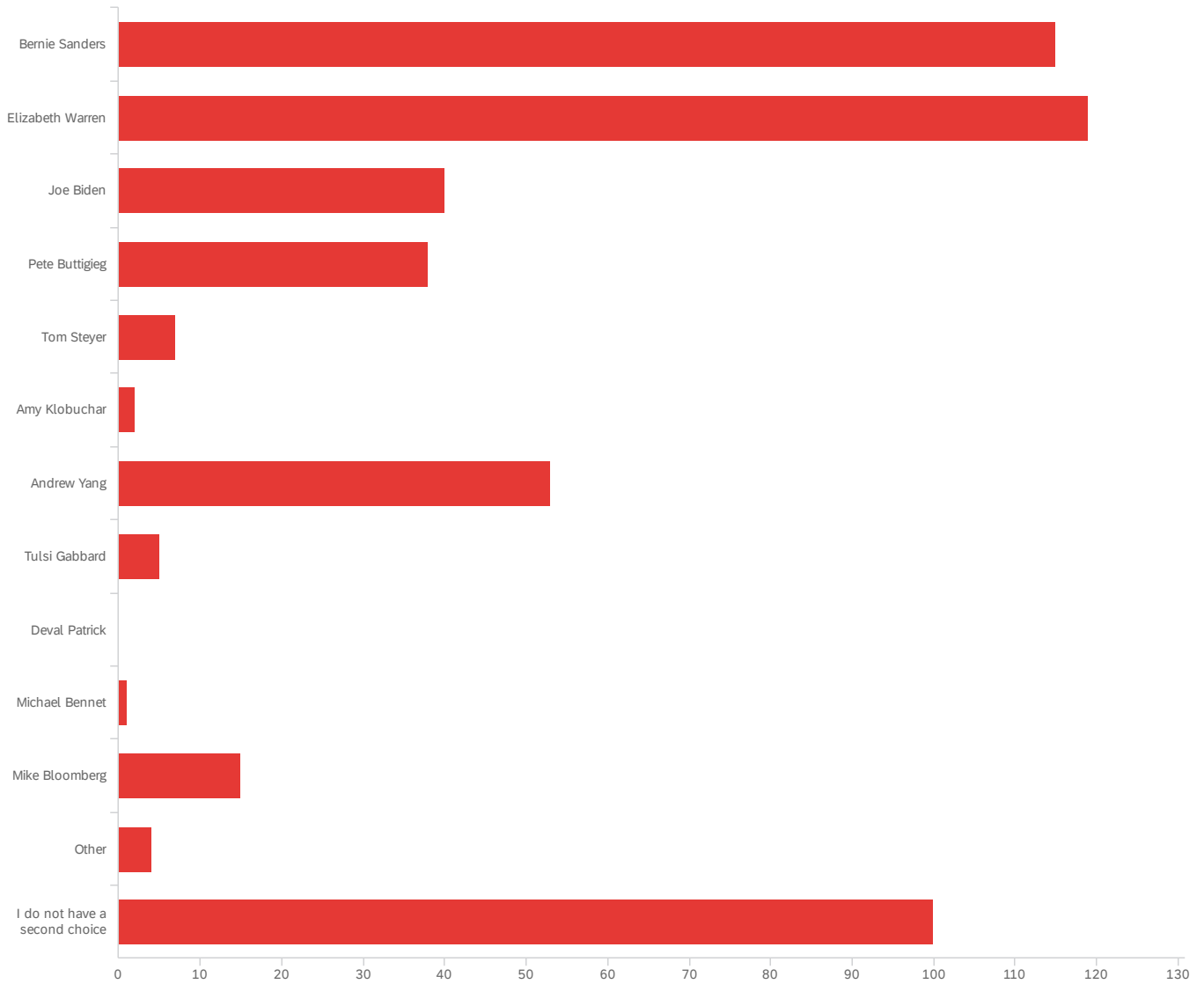

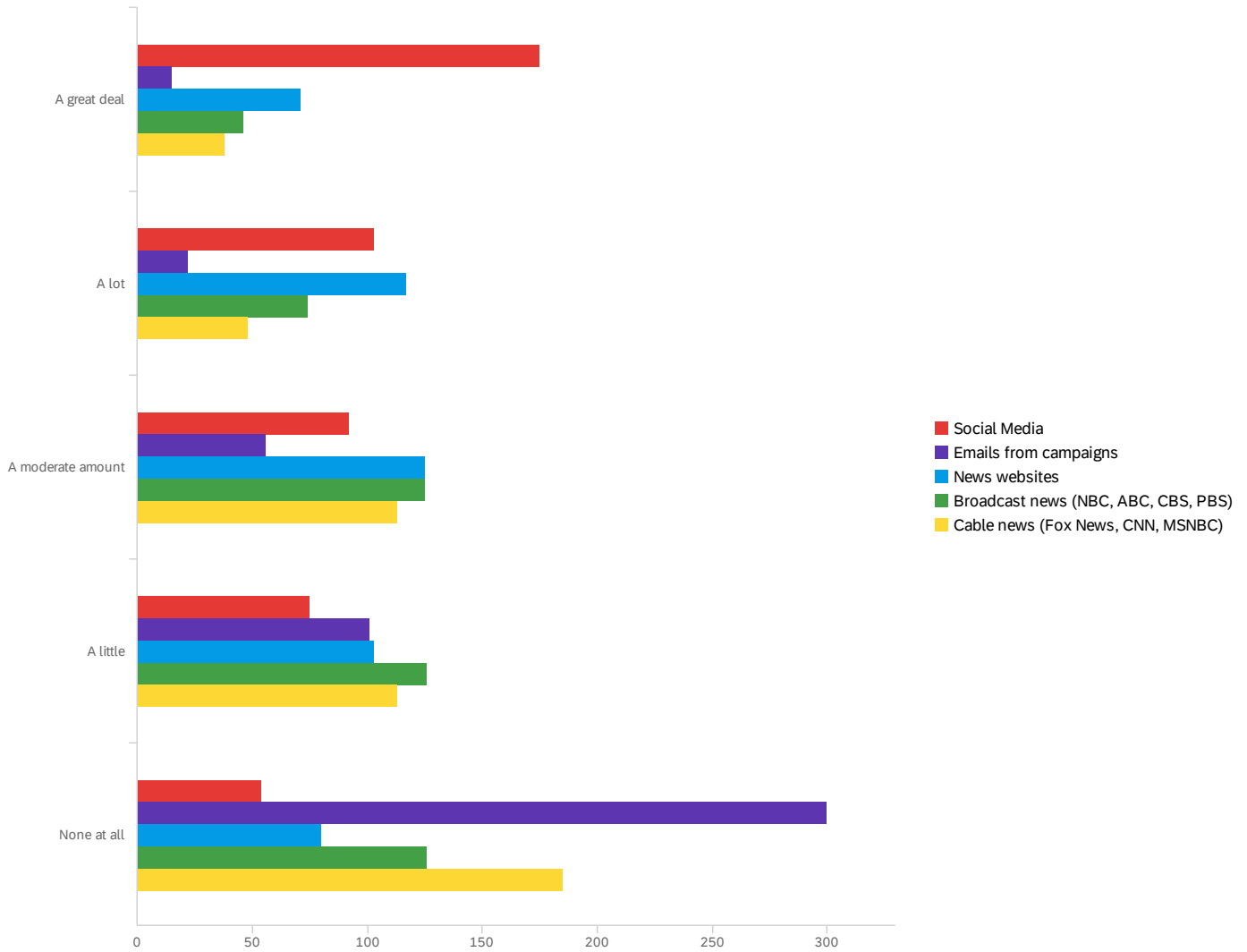

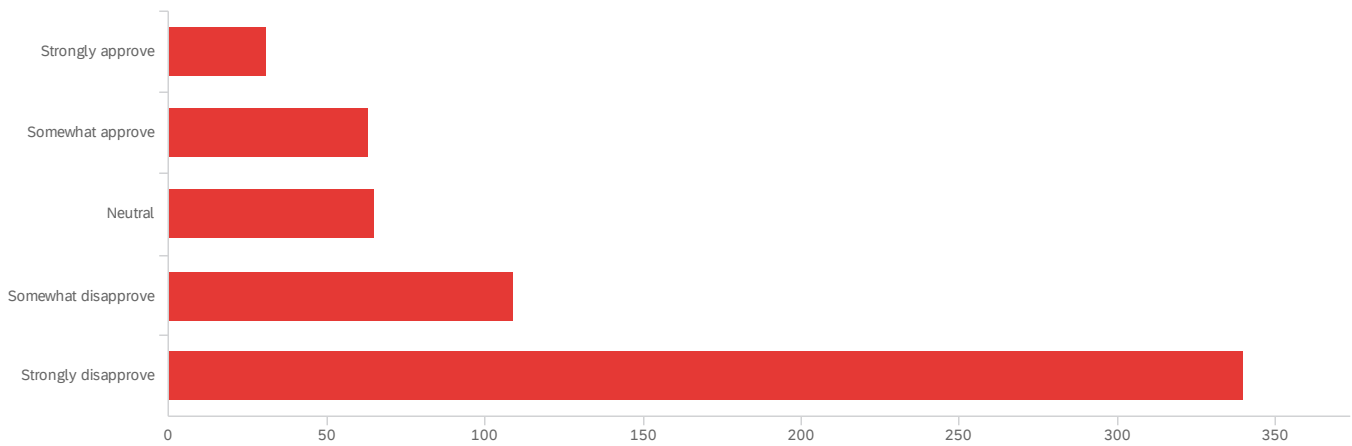

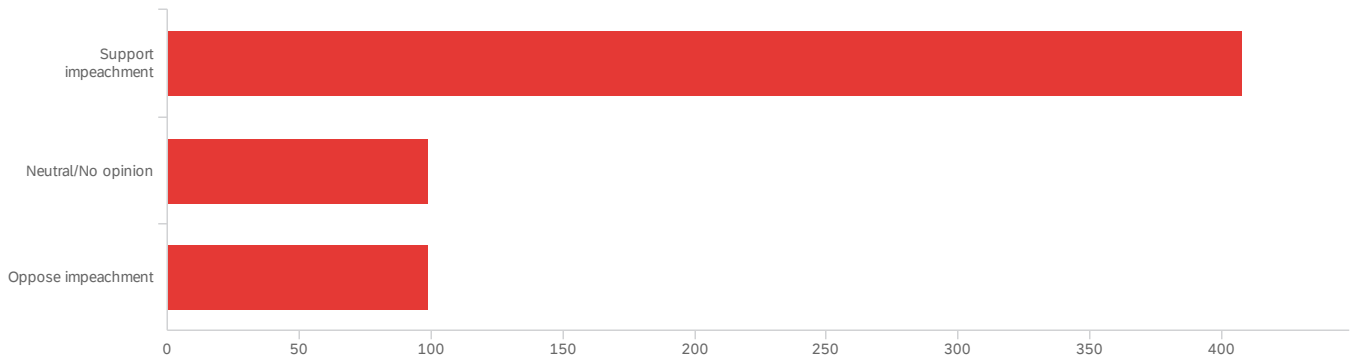

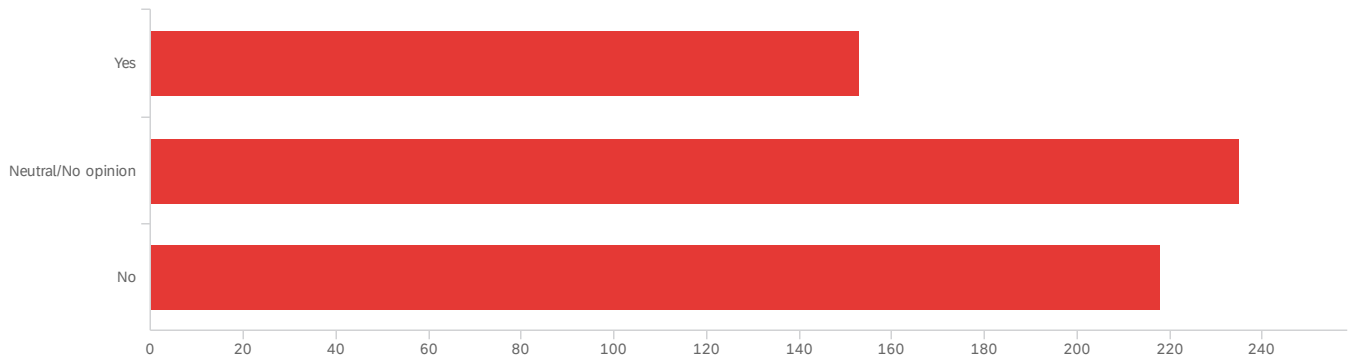

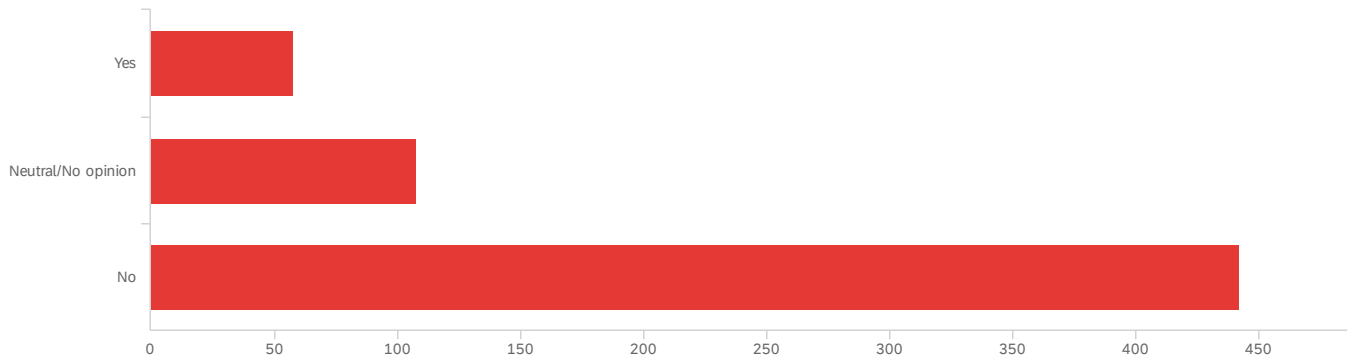

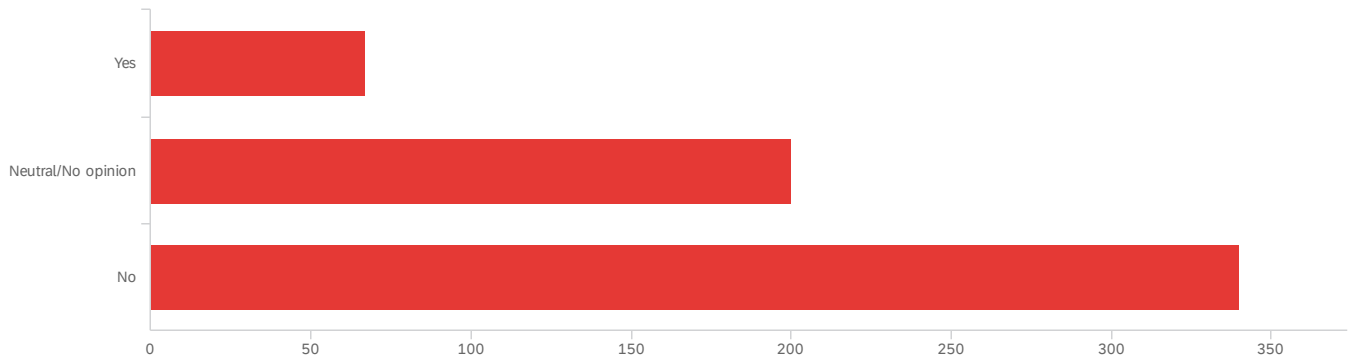

Q3.6 - Do you approve of President Trump's handing of trade policy?

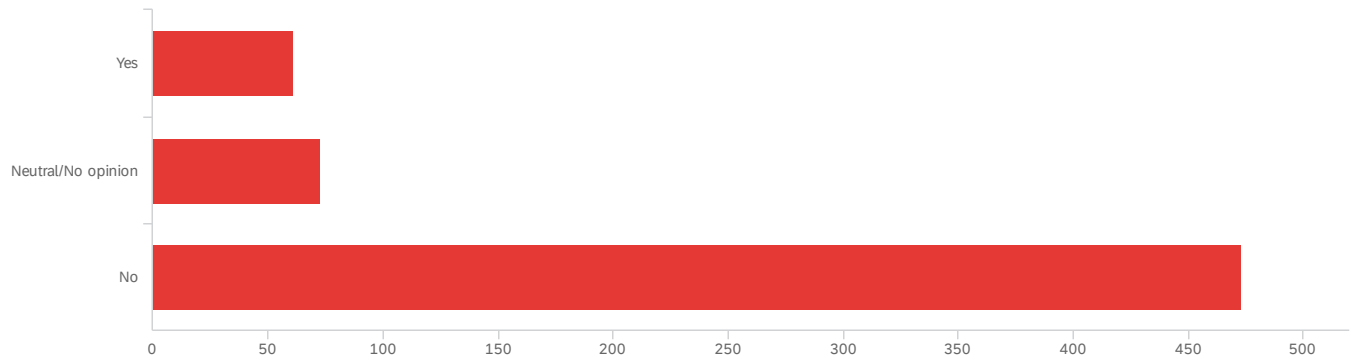

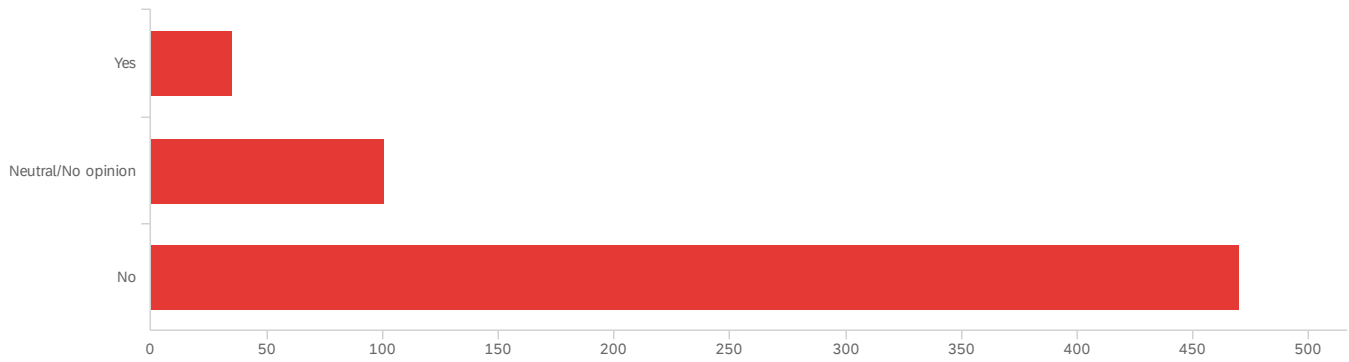

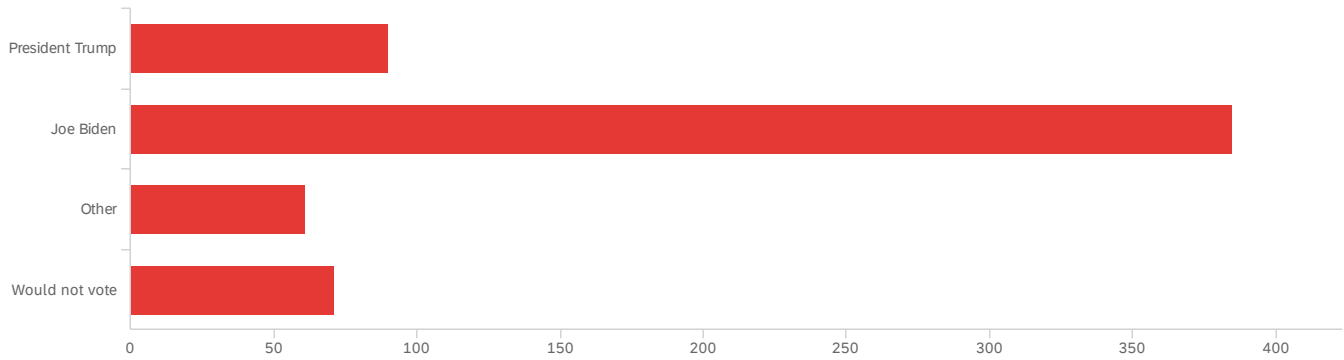

Q3.9 - In a hypothetical matchup between President Trump and Joe Biden, who would you support?



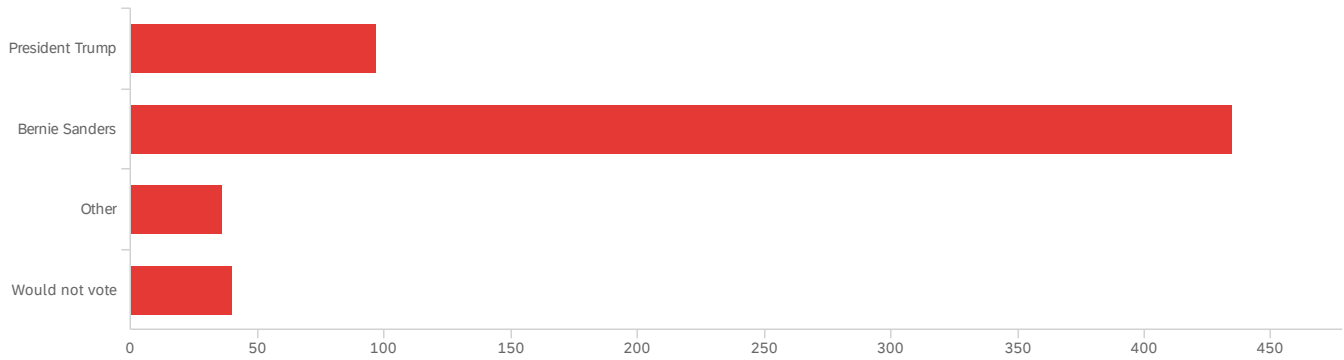

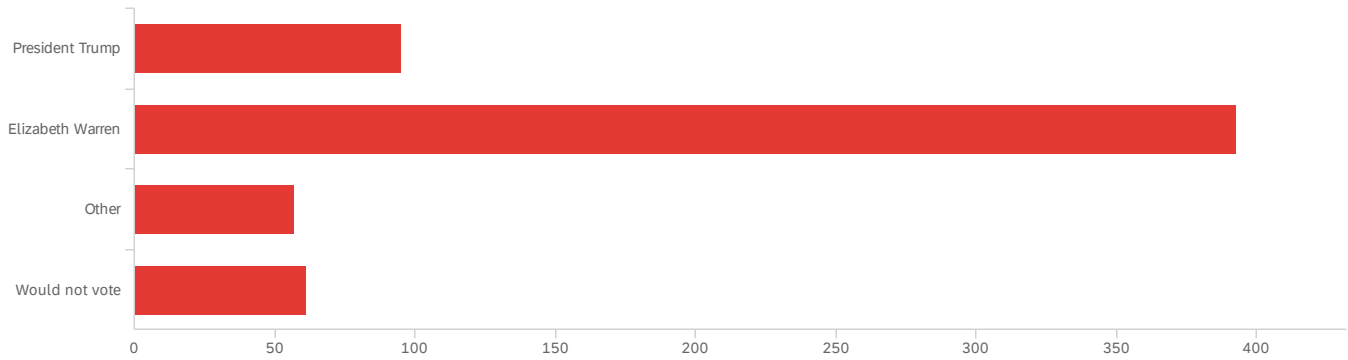

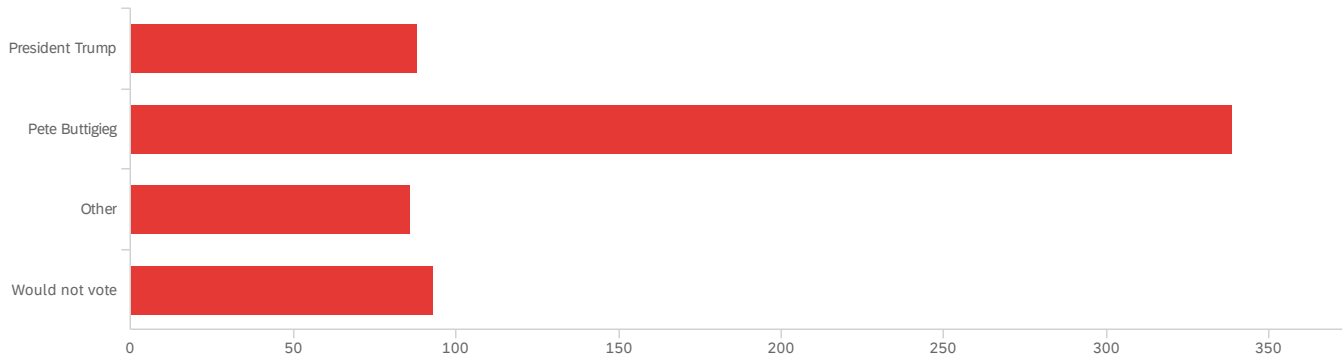

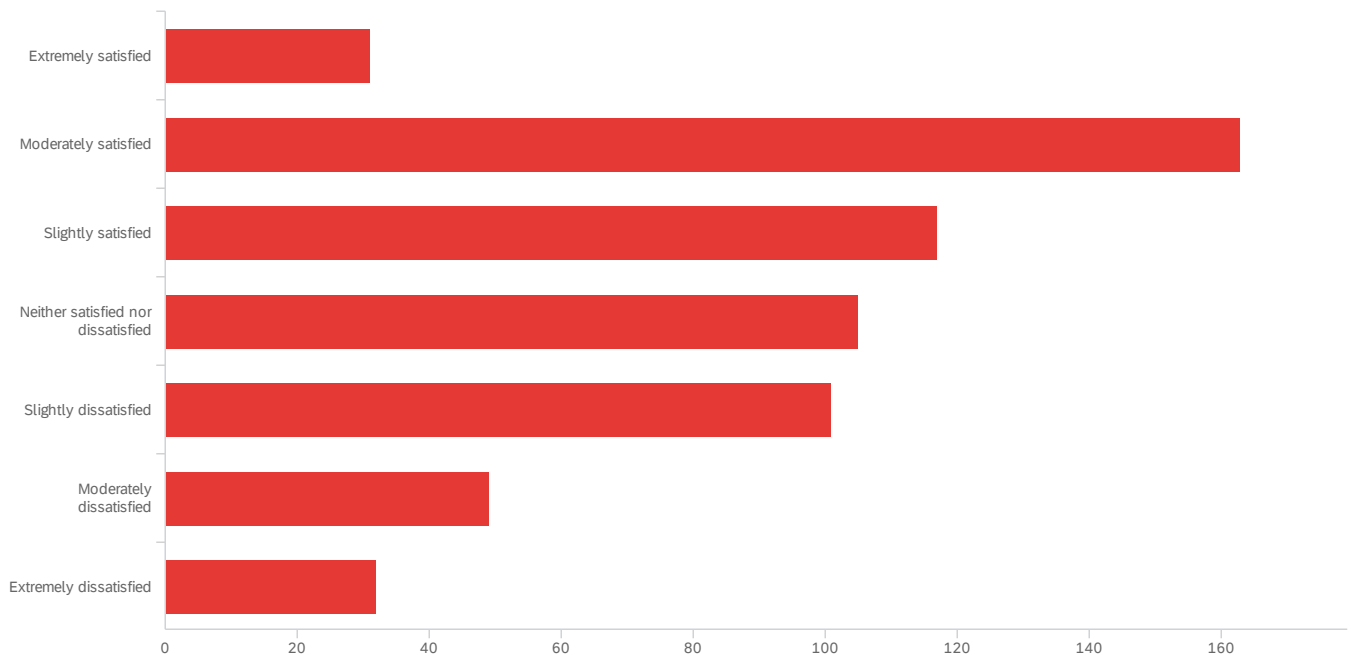

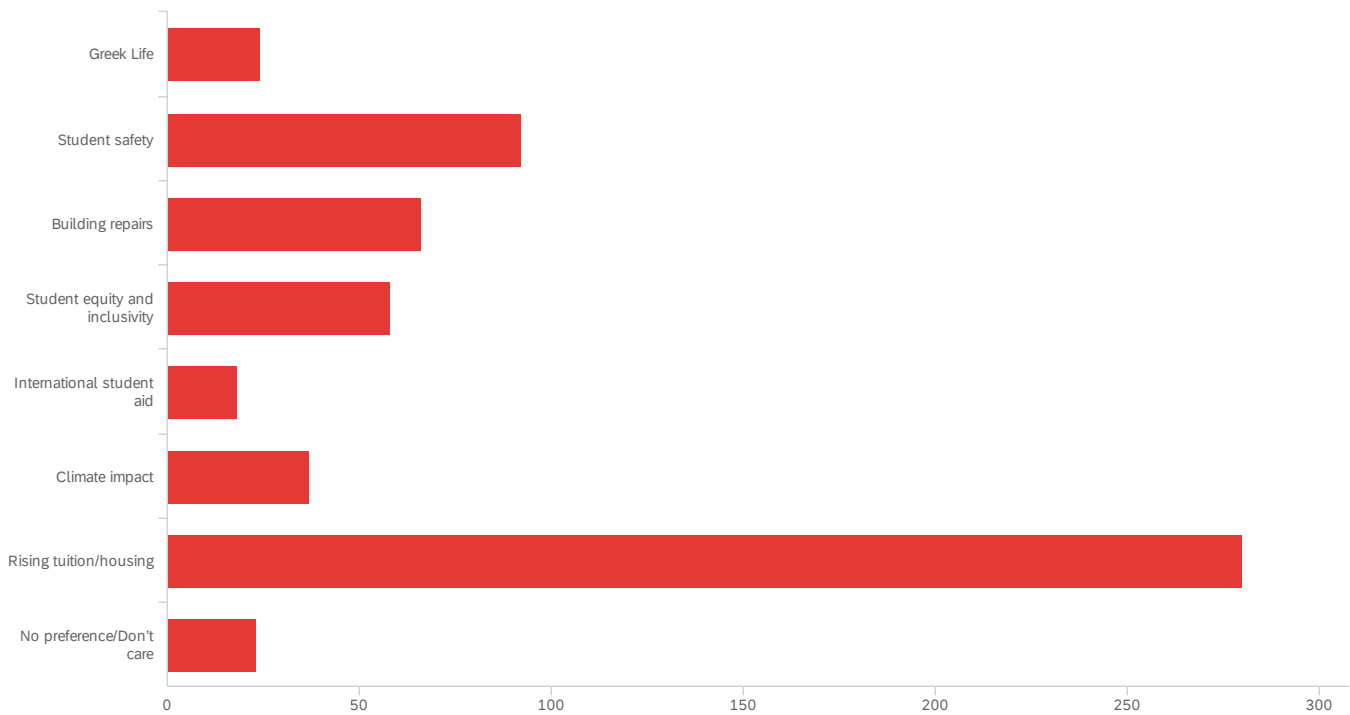

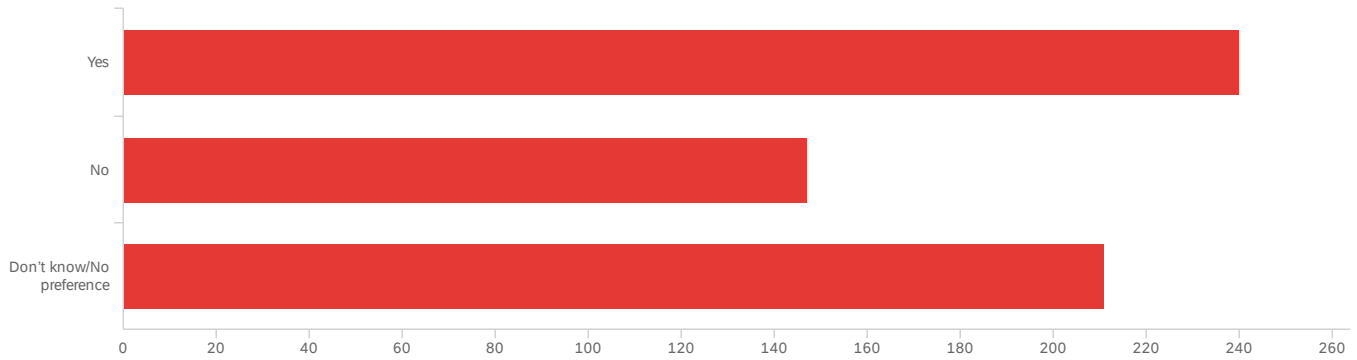

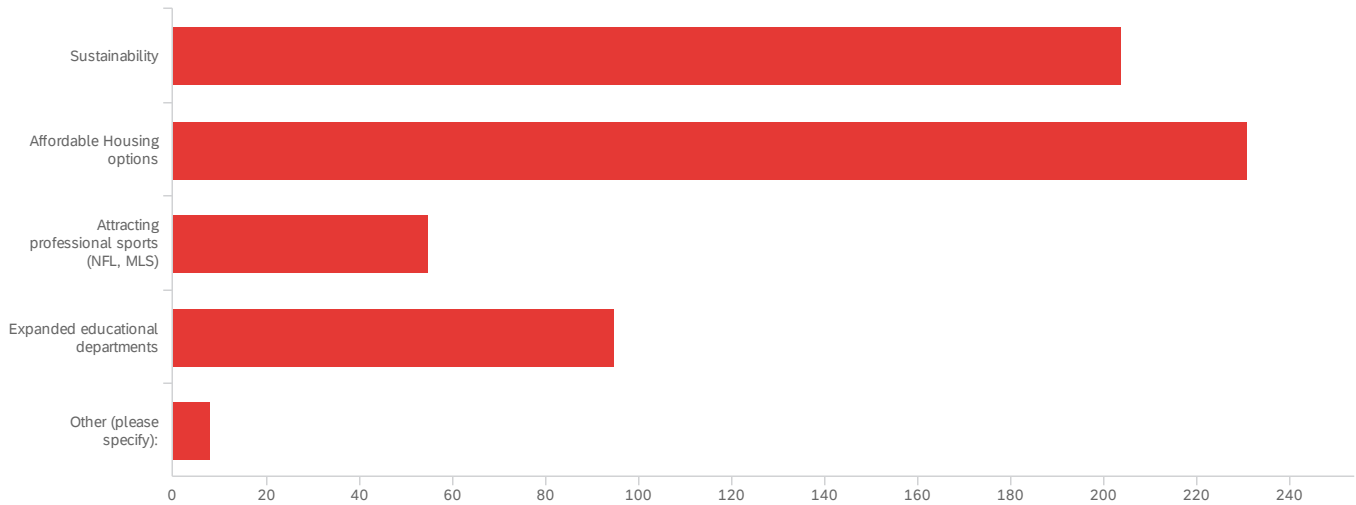

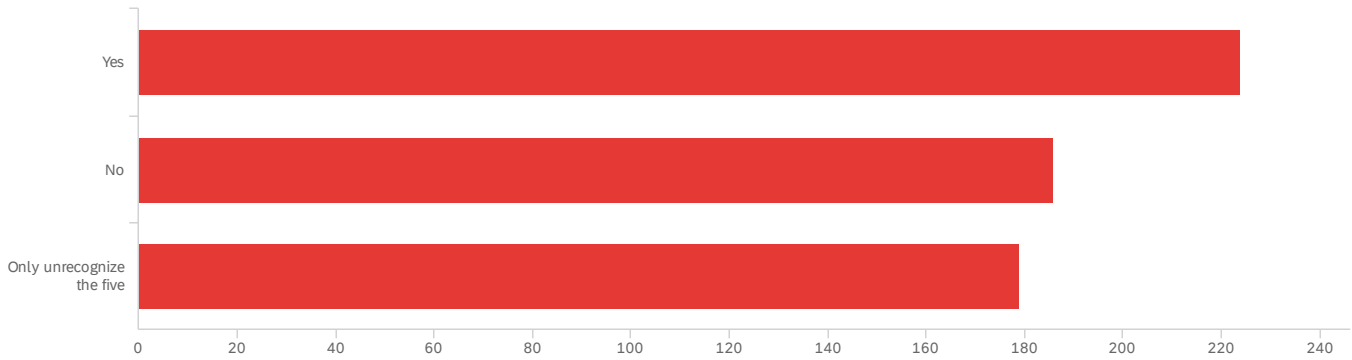

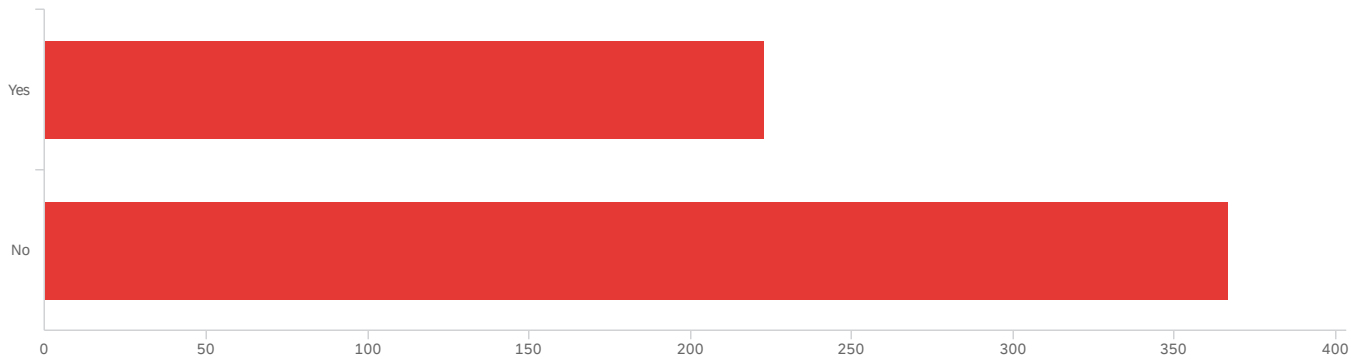

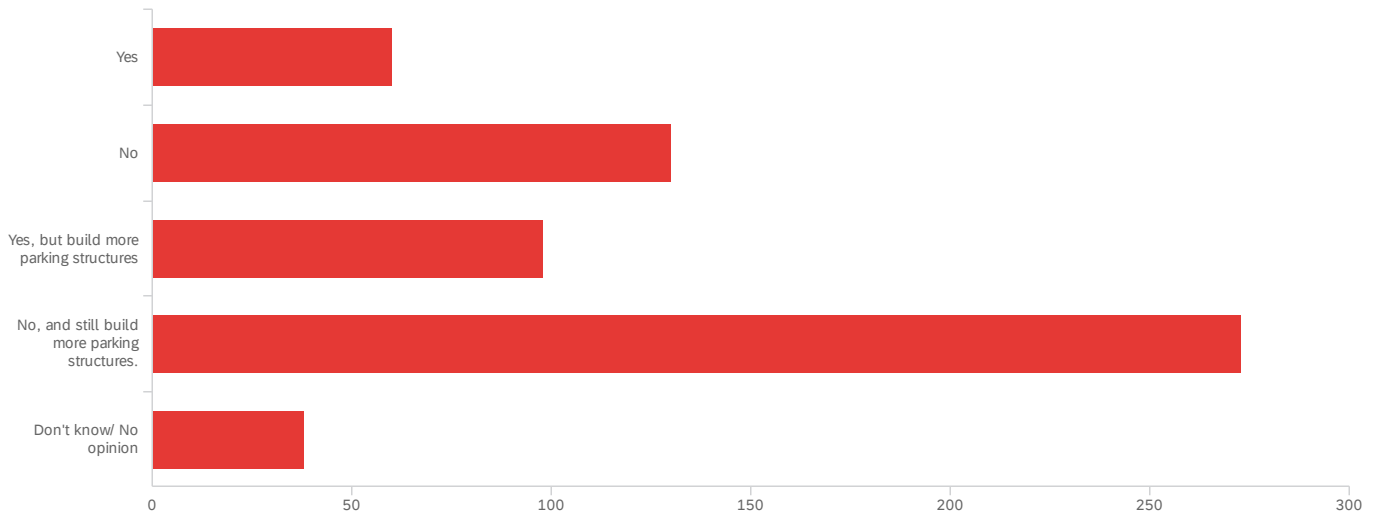

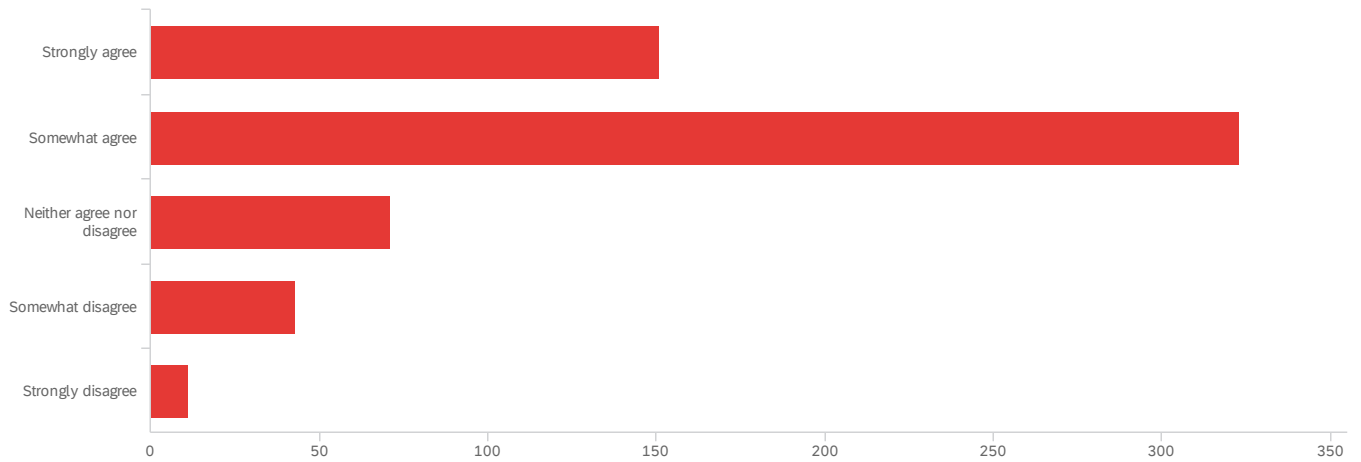

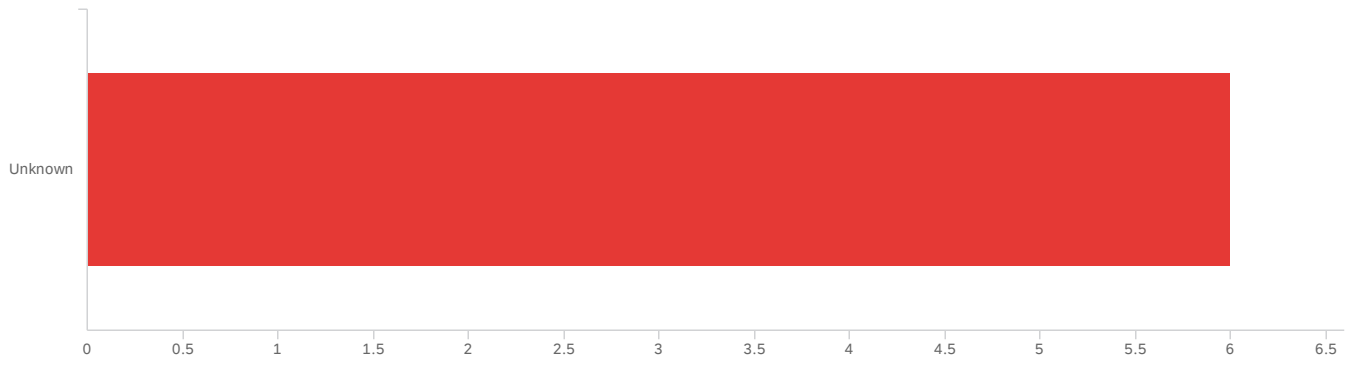

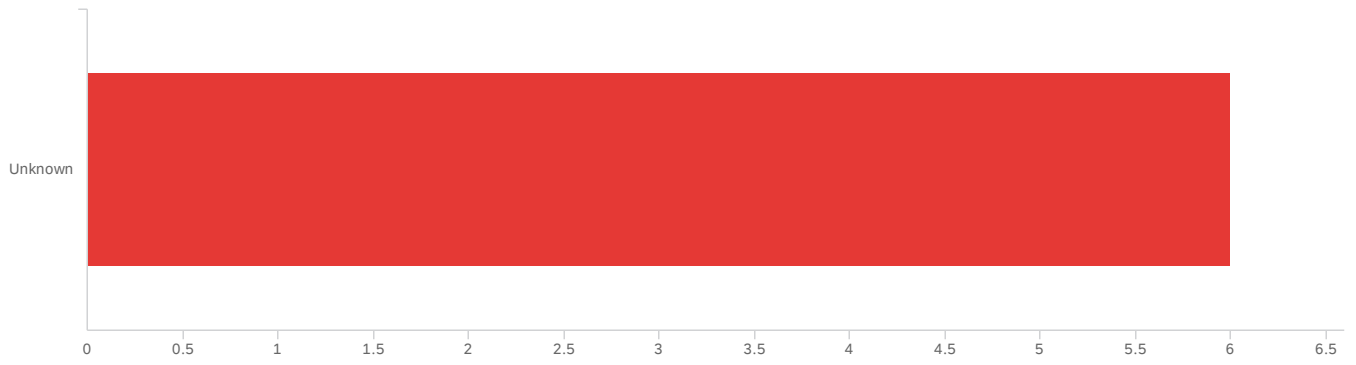
